ASEAN

- > Established in 1967
- ➤ 10 Member States: Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao People's Democratic Republic, Malaysia, Myanmar, the Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and Vietnam
- > 3 pillars: political-security; economic; socio-cultural
- > Around 600 M inhabitants
- ➤ Wide economic disparities (high middle and low income countries)
- ➤ Deadline: ASEAN Community to be in place by 2015

Free movement of skills under the AEC Blueprint

AFAS and Mode 4

- Mode 4: the less liberalised of the four modes
