The Government of the United Arab Emirates, as Chair-in-Office of the Global Forum on Migration and Development, and the Governments of Indonesia and Australia, as co-chairs of the Bali Process on People Smuggling, Trafficking in Persons and Related Transnational Crime, are pleased to invite you to participate in the 2020 GFMD Bali Process Regional Meeting.

The meeting will be held on Wednesday 25 March 2020 in Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates. This will follow the Bali Process Ad Hoc Group Senior Officials' Meeting, to be held on 23-24 March 2020.

The 2020 GFMD Bali Process Regional Meeting will focus on three thematic areas:

- Discussing Approaches to Address Irregular Migration
- Addressing Gaps in Migrant Protection
- Leveraging New Technologies to Empower Migrants.

Participants will have an opportunity to engage on all three themes and deliver input that will inform preparations for the GFMD Summit in Dubai in January 2021. Participation is open to all constituents of the GFMD.

Non-Bali Process participants may register one delegate each. Civil Society, the Business Mechanism and the Mayoral Mechanism may register up to ten participants each. International Organisations may register up to two participants each. Funding is available for up to five Civil Society participants.

The deadline for registration is 28 February 2020. Participants are requested to email support.unit@gfmd.org to register.


