

From Brain Drain to Brain Gain – A Compact for Skills Partnerships and Mobility

Side Event of the Global Forum on Migration and Development (GFMD) and the Intergovernmental Conference to Adopt the Global Compact for Migration (GCM)

The overarching goal of this two-part side-event is to contribute recommendations for the implementation of Objective 18 of the GCM targeting skills development and skills recognition. Special attention goes to global skill partnerships (e) which bear the potential to benefit destination countries, countries of origin as well as migrants (triple win). Relying on pre-departure initiatives, they could play a significant role for the establishment of new legal pathways by linking skills development and skills mobility in a mutually beneficial and equitable way.

With this side event, good practices of skill partnerships will be explored by taking a thorough look at the basic pre-requisites and key hurdles for these partnerships to function. We start with a presentation and discussion of good practices in the afternoon session at GFMD. Based on a stocktaking of existing bilateral initiatives between Germany, Morocco and other countries, possible lines of future joint ventures in the region will be considered. The results of the interactive debate will be then reflected during the following GCM side event in the evening. The subsequent networking reception offers opportunities for further informal exchange over dinner with practitioners and policy-makers. Furthermore, on this occasion the German-Moroccan Network of Competences (DMK e.V.) will launch its traveling exhibition “Migration and Vocational Training”.
