GENERAL INFORMATION

Morocco

The Kingdom of Morocco, with a population of over 33.8 million, is a unitary sovereign state located in the Maghreb region of North Africa. Geographically, Morocco is characterized by a rugged mountainous interior, large tracts of desert and a lengthy coastline along the Atlantic Ocean and Mediterranean Sea.

Morocco is a member of the Arab League, the Union for the Mediterranean, and the African Union. It has the fifth largest economy of Africa.

Religion and language

Morocco's predominant religion is Islam, and the official languages are Modern Standard Arabic and Amazigh (Berber). The Moroccan Arabic dialect, referred to as *Darija*, and French are also widely spoken.

Main sites (in Agadir)	Agadir sits by the Atlantic Ocean on Morocco's southern coast. Virtually destroyed and then rebuilt following an earthquake in 1960, it is the most modern of the country's cities, but still retains a sense of its past. Weather	Average temperatures in Agadir in the month of June range from a low of 22 C° to a high of 31°C. It is sunny 28 days out of 30 in average.
