

# The Impact of COVID-19 on Migrants, Migration and Development

## Response from Spain

**Title of policy/ action and main partners:**

Establishment of Minimal Vital Income scheme / Ministry of Inclusion, Social Security and Migration

**Main objective of the policy/ action:**

Fighting against new COVID-related socio-economic vulnerabilities, exclusion and prevention of risks of falling into poverty or involuntary subsequent exclusion or irregularity

**Main results:**

The scheme is accessible for nationals and for migrants and their families having at least one year of legal and interrupted residence in Spain. The scheme was passed in August.

**Title of policy/ action and main partners:**

Massive sanitary checks to seasonal foreign workers mainly in the primary sector / Ministry of Health, Ministry of Agriculture, Ministry of Inclusion, Social Security and Migration, Health systems of regional governments

**Main objective of the policy/ action:**

Avoiding spreading the disease and assure the protection of foreign workers and the communities they live in. Avoiding risks of Xenophobia and criminalization of foreign workers.
