

We welcome the innovation, the innovative perspectives, the entrepreneurial spirits, and the unique skill sets of skilled newcomers."



BUT WILL THEY MOVE: LIKELIHOOD TO CONSIDER MOVING FOR A NEW JOB IN ANOTHER COUNTRY






















#### Likelihood To Move To Another Country



## GLOBAL EMPLOYEES PLACE HIGH VALUE ON THE KIND OF COUNTRY THEY WOULD MOVE TO:










#### Top Countries To Relocate – Total
